Preface

On the occasion of the 400th anniversary of his birth, attention is once again focused on Hugo de Groot, the important representative of 17th-century Dutch culture.

Whilst in a certain sense Grotius can be regarded as one of the last men who could be called "homo universalis", it is his role as the founder of modern international law which gives him and his work a central place at the Peace Palace.

From the very start, the collection and study of his work has been given the utmost priority here. My predecessors, Molhuysen, Ter Meulen and Landheer, each proceeding from his own specific area of interest, have contributed greatly to this. In this way the Grotius collection, dating from the original donation by Martinus Nijhoff, and now world famous, came into being. It also formed the basis for the standard Grotius bibliographies compiled by Dr. J. ter Meulen and Dr. P.J.J. Diermanse.

At the present time there is a general tendency towards rationalisation which makes manpower and resources too scarce to be able to continue to carry on the thorough research projects mentioned.

For this reason I looked for a modest contribution our library could make to mark the Grotius commemoration which would be both worthwhile and attainable.

I am, therefore, especially pleased that the well-known Grotius expert, Dr. A.C. Eyffinger has been prepared to edit a catalogue of the collection. A suggestion to do this had already been made earlier by Mrs. I.L. Kost, but had not been realised.

The catalogue will appear at the same time in the Bibliographic Section of Grotiana.

I would like to express my grateful thanks to Dr. A.C. Eyffinger and Dr. H.J.M. Nellen of the Grotius Institute, Mr. J.C.M. Willems, L.L.M., of Grotiana and Mrs. I.L. Kost L.L.M. and Mr. D. Lughthart of the Peace Palace Library, for their kind and generous help.

May the catalogue serve as a practical and reliable guide for all those who come from all over the world to study our collection of Grotiana.

Introduction

The thoughts and ideas of Hugo de Groot are closely connected with the Peace Palace. This is reflected in the original function of the building as seat of the Permanent Court of Arbitration and in the composition of the library that is established there.

Not only was the formation of a Grotius collection an objective when setting up this library, but Martinus Nijhoff's generous gift of 55 editions of Grotius' legal masterpiece immediately formed, in the year of foundation, a firm basis for what has since expanded to becoming one of the most important collections of Grotius' works in the world. Its caretakers have not been content just to cherish it and for many decennaries the Peace Palace has, in fact, been a leading centre for the study of Grotius' spiritual heritage.

Prominent among these was Dr. Jacob ter Meulen, librarian from 1924 to 1952. He was the man behind the Hague Grotius exhibition in 1925 to mark the three hundredth anniversary of the publication of *De Jure Belli ac Pacis*, he was editor of the „Concise Bibliography of Hugo Grotius” published in that year and inspirer of the *Foundation to promote the Study of the Life and Works of Grotius* which was set up in 1949. The work of his successor Prof. Bart Landheer, however, should not be forgotten: just as Ter Meulen's research was directed to the historical Grotius, Landheer showed himself to be an exponent of the trend of thought – represented with right at the Peace Palace – which saw the great jurist as leader or at any rate inspirer in the solution of international disputes. Landheer gave his thoughts shape in the Grotius Seminarium established in 1954, which manifested itself via conferences (1958: *Ethical Values in International Decision Making*; 1961: *Limits and Problems of European Integration*) and reports.

However, the most striking evidence of the Grotius research at the Peace Palace is, indeed, the two Bibliographies, of Grotius's works and of the 17th century literature about them, published respectively in 1950 and 1961 and both the result of many years' cooperation between Jacob ter Meulen and Dr. P.J.J. Diermanse. At the same time this research has formed the basis for the steady growth of the Grotius collection in the Peace Palace library. One could indeed say that the initiative taken by the present director of the library, Mr. J.C. Schalekamp to produce a practical and usable catalogue of the Grotiana collection, not only reflects the modern desire for efficiency but at the same time follows a rich tradition.

The Grotiana editorial board has been more than glad to give its support to this initiative and Mr. J.C.M. Willems, its bibliographical

co-editor has generously given up the pages of the section at his disposal to the realization of this catalogue.

The catalogue contains the collection of printed works (mostly books, but also pamphlets and letters and poems published separately) and manuscripts of Grotius at the Peace Palace. With the exception of some biographical works the collection of other literature written about Grotius in the library has been left out. It is not representative in any field of the extensive literature which could be collected together. The Ter Meulen-Diermanse Bibliography (*TMD 1950*) has served as guide for the compilation of the catalogue, on the one hand because the makers had been convinced that to accept the bibliographic principles and the classification of this most complete bibliography of Grotius' works would encourage the very welcome standardization of reference in the literature about Grotius, and on the other hand, because the structural parallelism with the *TMD 1950* opened the possibility for them to present a wide field of data diagrammatically and compactly. After all, it released them from the necessity of adapting the short title principle, certainly unsatisfactory for Latin 17th century editions, which would entail frequent repetition of practically identical titles. The Ter Meulen-Diermanse plan contains a classification of Grotius' works according to subject area and within that a chronological presentation of the publications, in which the editions in the original language of publication always precede the translate editions.

Conveniently arranged presentation is essential for the dual purpose aimed at with this publication which is firstly, to offer a practical, compact conspectus of the Grotiana collection at the Peace Palace, in which all relevant details for researchers in widely differing disciplines are contained and secondly, to simplify the use of this important collection for the visitors of the library themselves. This objective also entailed inclusion in the catalogue of the collection of photocopies (many of rare works or works difficult to consult in the original form) even when this only concerned fragmentary reproductions of works. Just as in the *TMD 1950* the editions included in the form of a photocopy are indicated with a *p* and fragmentary reproductions with *pp*. Furthermore the year, place and size of the edition is also to be found in this catalogue as well as the editor, possibly the translator, and the publisher of the text and reference is made to the classification of the *TMD 1950* and to the signature of the library.

This catalogue has been prepared by J.C.M. Willems (*Grotiana*), H.J.M. Nellen (*Grotius Institute*), Mrs. I.L. Kost and D.F. Lugthart (*Peace Palace*) and the undersigned.

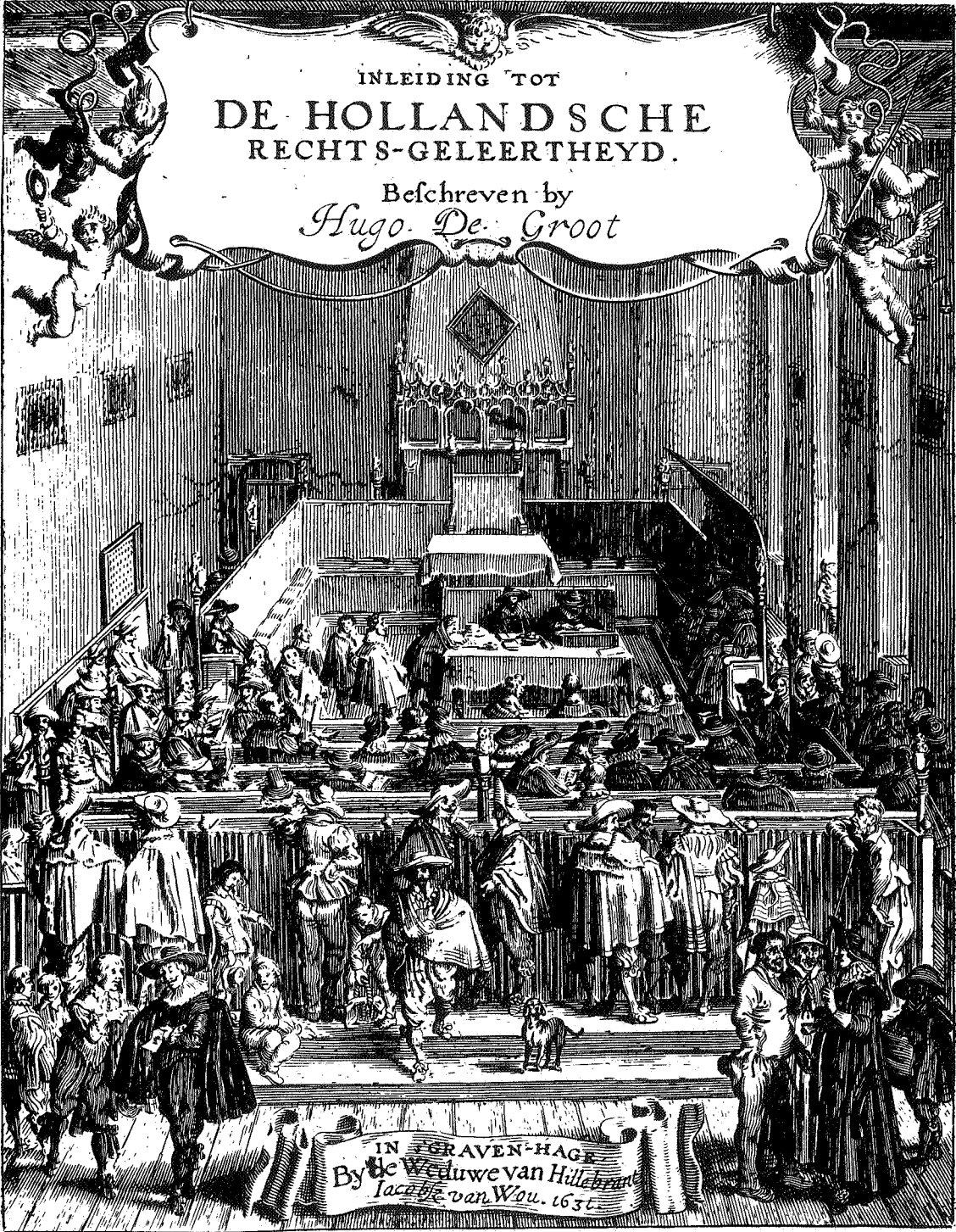
